Teaching both adults and children sewing arts she encourages her students to break out of their comfort zone and create something new. Jane has been sewing and crafting all her life and has been making fabric collage for over 15 years and is inspired by photos from nature.

Her most recent work featuring pet portraits have been featured on Quilting Arts TV and in Quilting Arts magazine and used as the cover art. She has work exhibited at the International Quilt Festival in Houston, Paducah, Sisters Oregon and various SAQA exhibitions. She is a member of Artistic Alchemy a small group of creative's who host an annual textile retreat at Lake Tahoe and can be found teaching workshops at IQF Houston, and Craft Napa.

**Jane will be teaching the following class at Western Nevada College, Room 311:**

Saturday, April 25 & Sunday, April 26, 2020 – **“Pet Portraits”**

In this two-day workshop, participants will learn how to enlarge a photo of a pet to about a 24” size design. Using a variety of fabrics, we will trace and fussy cut these fabrics and apply in a raw edge collage appliqué technique. On the 2nd day we will refine the fabrics and design and then start free motion quilting the pet portrait.
