Beginner We begin with simple practice blocks, learning the method of using a printed number paper and material to construct your block. [B]

Confident Beginner You can refresh prior knowledge on a practice block and move on to a more complicated piece. [CB]

Experienced Beginner Make an FPP wreath available in two sizes. [EB]



Materials List

1 ½” wide strips of fabric in at least two color ways in lights and darks.
Bring extra and more color ways (scraps] if you move up to Experienced Beginner

Sewing machine, scissors, ruler, seam ripper

*travel iron

*small cutting board

*small ironing mat

*rotary cutter

*light box or bright light

*We will have starred items available for your use, but having you own work station setup makes it a little easier.
