



Hawaiian Quilting Supplies

2nd Saturday, August 13, 2022

Teacher: Rose Swift

Project will be a 7 ½” square. You will learn all the techniques needed for a successful project that can be used in a purse, table topper, top or apron, etc. This is a hand sewing project, and requires no machine.

Supplies:

Needle of your choice (Betweens, sharps, etc.)
Long, thin needle for basting
Fabric clips or pins
Fabric scissors to cut through 8 layers
Small embroider/applique scissors
Stiletto/Purple Thang/etc. if desired
Thimble
Hand sewing kit
Basting thread
Thread to match your top fabric, preferably 100% cotton
Contrasting Prismacolor pencil and sharpener

Fabric: 100% cotton fabric

Solid colors are preferred for learning, and it is traditional to use darker fabrics on top with a lighter background. You will need a 7 ½” square of each color. If you have a purchased Hawaiian applique kit, bring it with you (ex. Pillow top, baby quilt, etc.)

For additional projects if you desire, bring 2 fat quarters, a lighter and a darker fabric and thread to match the top fabric.

The project will be based on the Hawaiian Quilt Font by Pokelele <https://www.fontsc.com/font/hawaiian-quilt>
I will provide the letters CVQG that will finish in 2 sizes – 15 – 16” and about 11 – 12”.
