Firecracker – Kaboom!!!

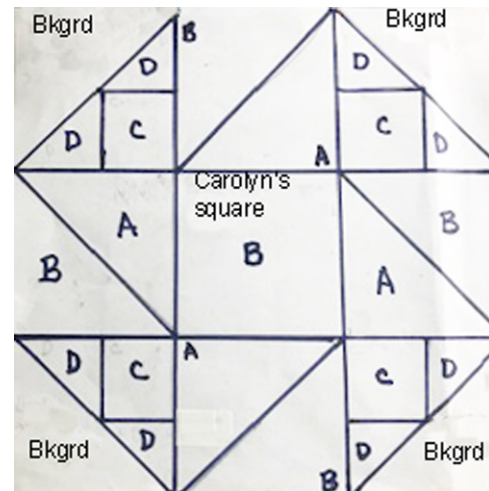
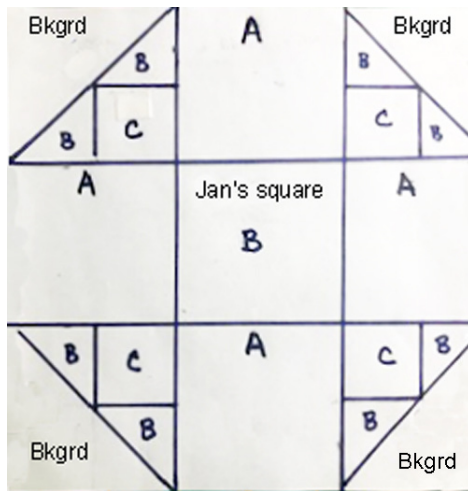


Fig 1 & Figure 2

Cutting Instructions:

Jan's Block:

Background – corner triangles

Cut two 4 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally

Fabric A – 4 squares around center block.

Cut four 4" squares

Fabric B – center block and small triangles in corner square

Cut one 4" square (Center)

Cut four 2 1/2" squares, cut in half diagonally

Fabric C small square in corner square

Cut four 2 1/4" squares

Carolyn's Block:

Background – corner triangles

Cut two 4 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally

Fabric A – 4 triangles around center block that are sewn to fabric B triangles to make a square

Cut two 4 1/4 "squares cut in half diagonally

Fabric B – center square and triangles that are sewn to Fabric A triangles

Cut one 4" square (center square)

Cut two 4 1/4 "squares cut in half diagonally

Fabric C – small square in corner square

Cut four 2 1/4" squares

Fabric D – small triangles in corner square

Cut four 2 1/2" squares, cut in half diagonally

Assembly:

Lay out pieces first!

The block is constructed like a 9-patch block. It will be built in rows. Trim Squares to 4"

Step 1. Assemble corner Square – Make 4

Sew small corner triangles to the side of Fabric C square. See picture below for alignment.

Sew complete triangle to Background triangle.

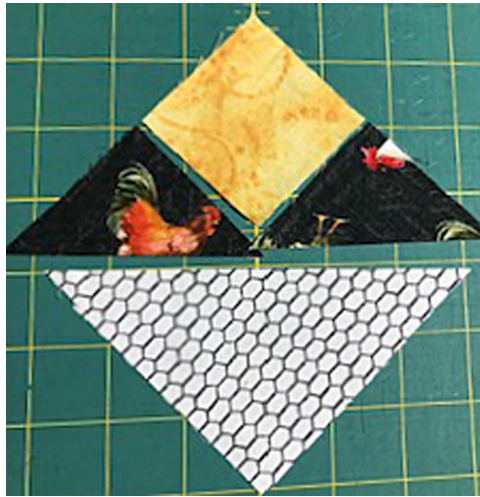

Step 2. For Carolyn's block: sew Fabric A triangle to Fabric B triangle – make 4 squares. It is used in step 3

Step 3. Assemble top and bottom rows of block (2 rows)

Sew corner square to each end of Fabric A square or 'step 2 square' for Carolyn's Block.

See pic below-check direction of half square triangle to make sure you are making the star

Step 4: center row:

Sew Fabric A square (step 2 square for Carolyn's block) to each side of center square

See pic below-check direction of half square triangle to make sure you are making the sta

Step 5 Sew rows together
