

Block of the Month August 2022 Flower

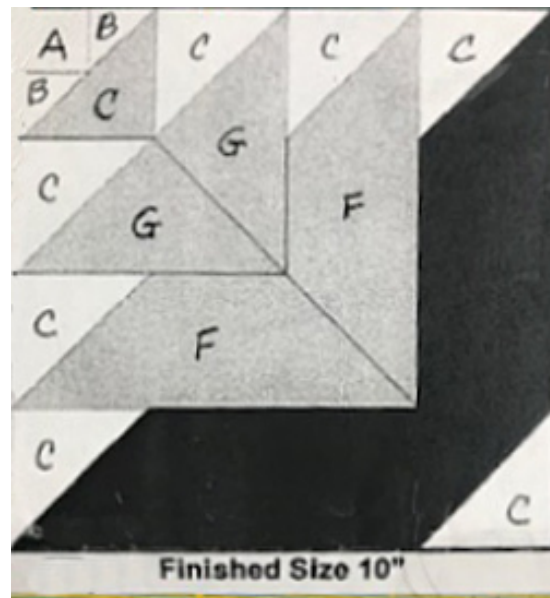

Cutting Instructions:

Background –

Cut one 2 ½” square; cut in half diagonally (Piece B)

Cut four 3 ½” squares; cut in half diagonally (Piece C- white in diagram above), there is one extra triangle

Stamen – Piece A

Cut one 1 ¾” square

Flower – Piece C- shaded and piece G

Cut one 3 ½” square; cut in half diagonally (Piece C-shaded in diagram above), there is one extra

Triangle

For Piece G can use template G (cut 2) or cut one 4 ½” square; cut in half diagonally

For Piece F - cut 2 from template F

Leaf:

Template D and E: Cut 1 of each

Assembly:

Lay out pieces first! Use diagram above as a guide. Use 1/4" seams. Block will measure 10 1/2" with seam allowance

Unit One is in the upper right-hand corner and will use pieces A, B, Shaded C (flower piece) and 2 of the background C pieces. Make sure you have 1/4" on top piece for the

point

Unit 2 is the flower and leaf section. It uses pieces Background C, G, and template E,F,D.

Sew Background C pieces to each piece of templates D, E and F. Background C is chicken wire fabric, green is F, black is D. This picture is right side. Do the same for left side. Then sew E and F strip together and add G on top

Right side

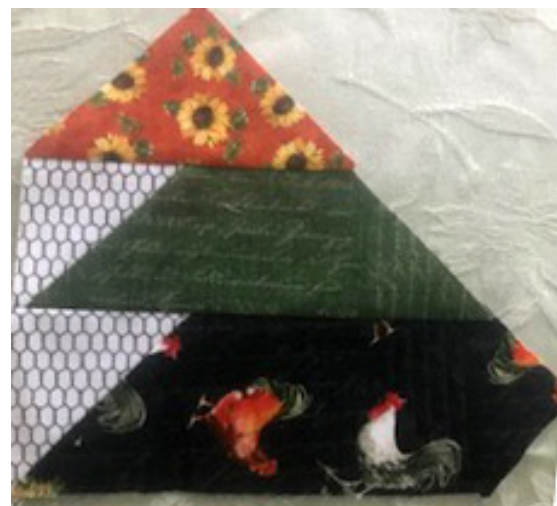

Sew Left stacked side to stacked right side, down the middle. Match the seams

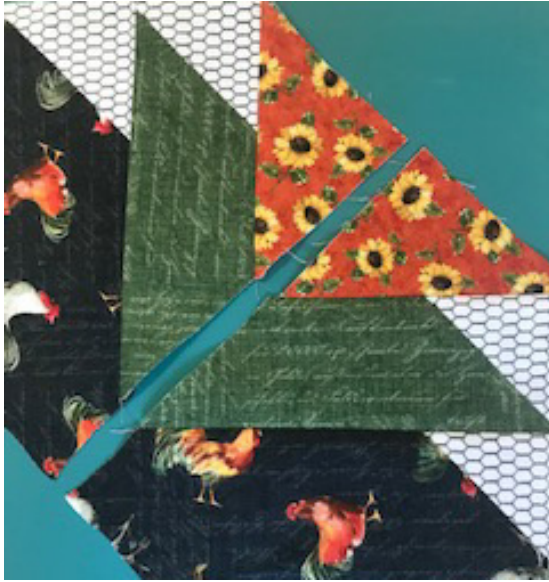
