

Block of the Month September 2022  
Maple Leaf

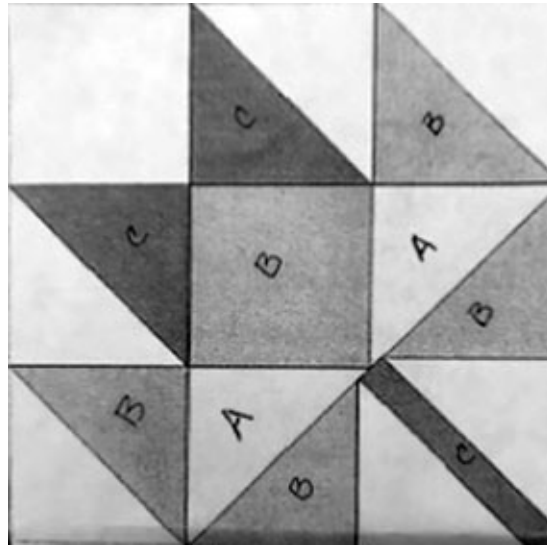

**Cutting Instructions:**

The colors in parentheses are the fabric colors of the sample block. Pick the fabric you want. Letters on Pattern denote the color listed below. Stack triangles by size when cutting.

**Background (chicken wire fabric):**

Cut two 4 1/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally

Cut two 4" squares. Cut one in half diagonally

Color A (red fabric)

Cut one 4 1/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally

Color B (black fabric)

Cut two 4" squares. Cut one in half diagonally

Cut one 4 1/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally

Color C (yellow-gold fabric)

Cut one 4 1/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally

Cut one 1 1/4" x 5 3/4" rectangle

**Assemble: Lay out PIECES!!!**

Build block in 4 units. Watch direction of triangles. Make sure to match 4 1/4" triangles together. Do the same for 4" triangles.

**Unit 1 - Triangle in the Middle (black square with 2 red triangles)**

Sew Piece A triangles (red fabric) to sides of 4" square Piece B (black fabric)

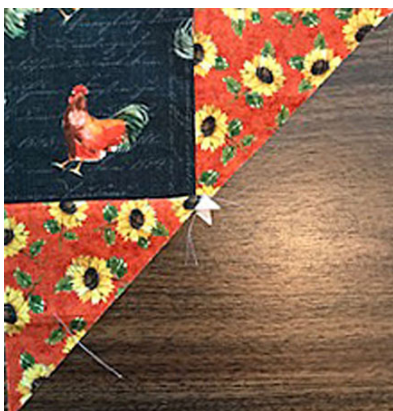


Figure 2 (Unit 1)

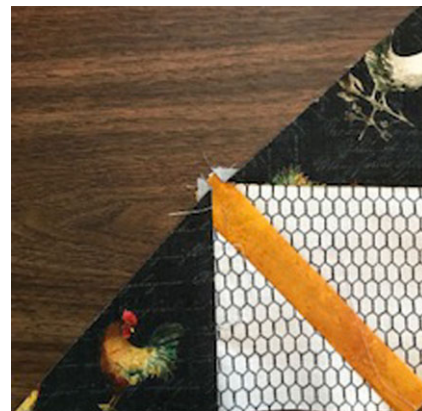


Figure 3 (Unit 2)

Unit 2 - Right Bottom Triangle (Black triangles with chicken wire stem unit)

Sew long side of Background triangle to each side of Color C rectangle (Stem Unit).

Trim stem at bottom to make a square corner. Make sure stem is in the middle!

Not like the picture!

Sew Piece B triangle (black) to each side of Background Piece triangle of Stem unit

Sew Unit 1 and 2 together. See picture below

Unit 3 - Top Row of Block

Square 1 – 4 1/4” background square

Square 2 – Sew triangle C to background triangle- be sure they are both 4 1/4” triangles

Square 3 – Sew triangle B to background triangle

Sew together in the above order.

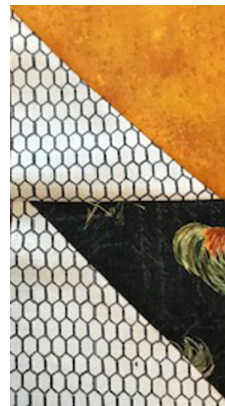


Figure 6 (Unit 4)

Unit 4 – Lower left side of block (2 bottom squares)

Square 1 – Sew triangle C to background triangle

Square 2 - Sew triangle B to background triangle

Sew together in the above order. See diagram above

Sew Unit 4 to Left side of Unit 1 and Unit 2 combo.

Sew Unit 3 to top of Unit 1,2, and 4 combos  
Press carefully. Trim Block to 10 1/2"
