Supply List for Quilted Fabric Sculptures:

- 1 yard or 2 half yards of cotton fabric in desired colors for your vase or bowl. The flowers require 1-2 yards of fabric (Hand-dyed fabric will be for sale in class.)
- · Sewing machine with free-motion quilting foot and walking foot
- Sewing supplies: scissors, pins, threads to match your fabric; rotary cutter and mat; needle for hand sewing: fabric glue
- Optional -embellishments (yarn, beads); heat gun (optional)
 - Kit fee is \$15. The kit contains: heat-moldable batting (enough to make several bowls/flowers or one vase and one flower), pattern and instructions.

Supply List for Land- and City Scapes:

- Fabric pieces (fat quarters or larger), some prints that remind you of rocks, grass, water, sky, etc. preferably batiks and/or hand-dyed. Hand-dyed fabric will be for sale during the workshop, \$23/yard.
- 2 yds of fusible web (with paper backing) such as Wonder Under (Pellon 805) or Steam-a-Seam
- 1/2 yard of batting
- 1/2 yard of backing fabric
- Sewing supplies including scissors, pins, machine embroidery threads, Teflon pressing sheet and travel iron (optional, we will have irons in the classroom), rotary cutter and board
- Sewing machine in good working order with a free-motion or darning foot.
- Your photograph of a landscape you would like to interpret Or,
- If you would like to use one of Marjan's patterns (choices are: Lake Tahoe, Golden Hills, Golden Gate Bridge, Coastal Cliffs, Yosemite Falls, Big Sur, Mount Shasta and Monterey Bay) they are \$10 each.
