You should be able to make a couple of these boxes while you are in class.

We will be making the 10" version

You will need:

1 10" square of batting

1 each 10" square of contrasting fabrics, could be a light print and a matching dark print or novelty prints that contrast.

To make 2 or 3 boxes, bring duplicates of the above batting and fabric

Buttons to match, or embellishments you would like to use.

Bring your sewing machine in good working order

Thread to match your projects

Walking foot attachment if you have one

Marking pen or pencil

Ruler and seam guide if you have one

Scissors, and something you can turn your square with (like That Purple Thang)

Plus, normal pins, machine needles, etc
