Saturday, April 22, 2023: *Land- and City Scapes*

Create your own original Landscape wall quilt. Learn about essential design principles to make a beautiful fantasy view or bring that inspiring photograph or use one of my patterns (choices are: Lake Tahoe, Golden Hills, Golden Gate Bridge, Coastal Cliffs, Yosemite Falls, Big Sur, Mount Shasta and Monterey Bay; \$10 each). This workshop is suitable for new and experienced quilters. We'll be creating a fabric collage using fused applique, free-motion machine embroidery and thread painting. Bobbin drawing and couching will provide extra texture.

Class will be from 10:00 - 4:00 at Carson Valley United Methodist Church in our regular meeting room.

Plan to be there at 9:30 to set-up. Bring a sack lunch and beverage to class.

Sunday, April 23, 2023: *Quilted Fabric Sculptures*

Learn how to make three-dimensional quilted fabric sculptures. In this 6-hour class you will make a quilted vase, bowl, or flower, but with the technique taught in this class, you can create many different quilted 3D shapes. Your imagination is the limit...

Kit fee is \$15. The kit contains: heat-moldable batting (enough to make several bowls/flowers or one vase and one flower), pattern and instructions.

Class will be from 10:00 - 3:00 at Douglas County Community Center in the North Room

Plan to be there at 9:30 to set-up. Bring a sack lunch and beverage to class.
