

Good Endings Workshop

The purpose of the workshop is to learn the basics and beyond for finishing the edge of a quilt. During the workshop we will practice the techniques by making samples to take home.

Sample 1 – Continuous binding

Make continuous binding strips

Sample 2 – Binding to the backside

Make a French fold finish and a machine finish

Sample 3 – Binding to the front side

Make a blindside finish and a decorative finish

Sample 4 – Corners

Make a folded corner and a miter corner

Sample 5 – Connecting the ends

Insert an end and insert a bias end

Sample 6 – Novelty bindings

Make a flange binding and make a corded binding

Supplies:

10 or 12 pieces of 4" x 8" rectangles (any colors)

3 Strips – 2-1/2" x WOF

Sewing machine and thread

Hand needles and quilt pins

Rotary cutter and mat (there are mats at workshop, but having your own will be helpful)

Batting will be supplied by Carolyn
