### Workshop #1 – Twinkle

(Sat, Sept 21, UMC, 9:30 – 3:30)

Skills taught: “Liberated (star) blocks” and how to assemble blocks of different sizes and shapes into a harmonious quilt.

### Workshop #2 – Monaco Magic (Sun, Sept 22, DCCC, 9:30 – 3:30)

What a way to use up scraps (or not)! A “flip and sew” technique will be taught to attach strips to a foundation fabric to create a versatile block. No fussy measuring; make a quick inexpensive quilt or 20” pillow. Be as calm or as crazy as you like!
