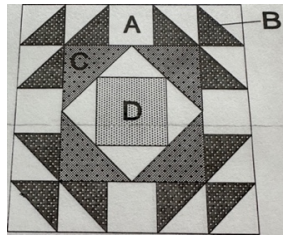


Block of the Month - July 2024

Block 7 - Columbine

July Block

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A (white)

Cut six 3" squares. Cut in half diagonally. Makes 12 triangles. Use with Fabric B triangles.

Cut four 2 1/2" squares. Use on outside edge.

Cut one 4 1/4" square. Cut square on both diagonals. Make 4 triangles. Use on center square.

Fabric B (black)

Cut six 3" squares. Cut in half diagonally. Makes 12 triangles. Use with Fabric A triangles.

Fabric C (blue plaid)

Cut two 4" squares. Cut in half diagonally. Use on 2nd round of triangles around center square.

Fabric D (med blue)

Cut one 3 1/2" square (Center Square).

Assemble in 3 rows: 10 1/2" unfinished Block.

Rows 1 and 3

Sew 12 Fabric A to Fabric B triangles. Make 12 squares. Trim 2 1/2" square

Unit 1 Sew two Fabric A/B squares together. Make 4 rectangles (4 squares left over -use in Row 2)

Sew a unit 1 rectangle to each end Fabric A, 2 1/2" square, make 2. fig 5 & 6 below.

Look at figures 5 & 6 below to make sure diagonals of squares are going the correct way.

Row 2: Center of Block

Mark fabric D as shown in fig 1. Place Fabric A triangle on square D as shown in fig. 1.

Sew Fabric A triangles to opposite side of center square. Press all seams towards triangle.

Sew remaining 2 Fabric A triangles to the other sides of center square. Trim block 4 3/4". Fig.2

Sew color C triangles to 4 3/4" center unit in the same way. Trim block 6 1/2". Fig 3.

Sew a Fabric A/B square to each side of a Fabric A, 2 1/2" square. Make 2- sides of row 2, Fig. 4

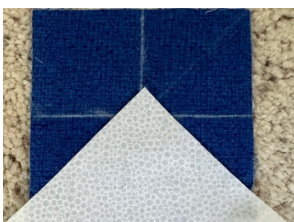

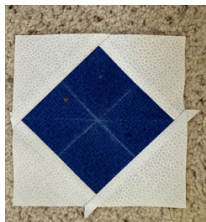
