Chris Lynn Kirsch (www.chrisquilts.net) -- Chris enjoys traditional patchwork, creating fiber art, and just about everything in between. She has taught throughout the US (incl. the AQS Quilt Show in Paducah, KY) and has authored five books on her unique techniques. Her award-winning quilts have been displayed though out the world at locations such as: American Quilters Society Shows; National Quilt Museum (Paducah, KY), IQA Festival (Houston, TX), Quilt Expo Europa, World Quilt & Textile Show (Christchurch, New Zealand).

Workshops:

1) Seminole Borders – CLASS IS FULL!!! Simple strip piecing, cross-cutting and



straight or diagonal re-sewing, can add a border that takes your quilt from simple to simply fantastic.

Samples of a number of different Seminole patterns will be made to keep as a reference for future projects, or they may be stitched into your own "Seminole Sampler".


This In-person workshop will be held Saturday, September 20, 2025, 9:30 am – 3:30 pm, United Methodist Church, Gardnerville, NV

Kits = The instructor will not supply fabric kits for the borders. Cutting instructions for a "you-make-your-own-kit" will be emailed to participants in August. If you paid for a kit at a prior meeting, but want to make your own, come by the National Teacher table at the next guild meeting for your refund. If you want to have Louise and Amy make a fabric kit for you, the cost is \$15 (goes to the guild) and you need to specify

what colorway you'd like – see you at the National Teacher Table.

2) Architectural Repliqué - Picture your home as a quilt. By using the technique from Chris' first book you'll be able to recreate any photograph as an accurate fabric replica in machine appliqué. No fusible, templates or degree in art required. In the first half of class students will learn to Repliqué on a sample block. In the second



half, the students will complete their blocks while Chris works one on one with each quilter to determine fabric placement and appliqué order for their own picture.
