

Moon Over The Mountain (Applique)

9 inch, 6 inch, and 3 inch block patterns (23, 15, & 7.5 cm)

Moon Over The Mountain is an easy applique pattern.

When you are doing applique, allow 1/4" seam allowance.

Turn under seam allowance on the circle (clipping to create a smooth line), trim away the portion that falls under the "mountain," leaving the 1/4" allowance on the triangle.

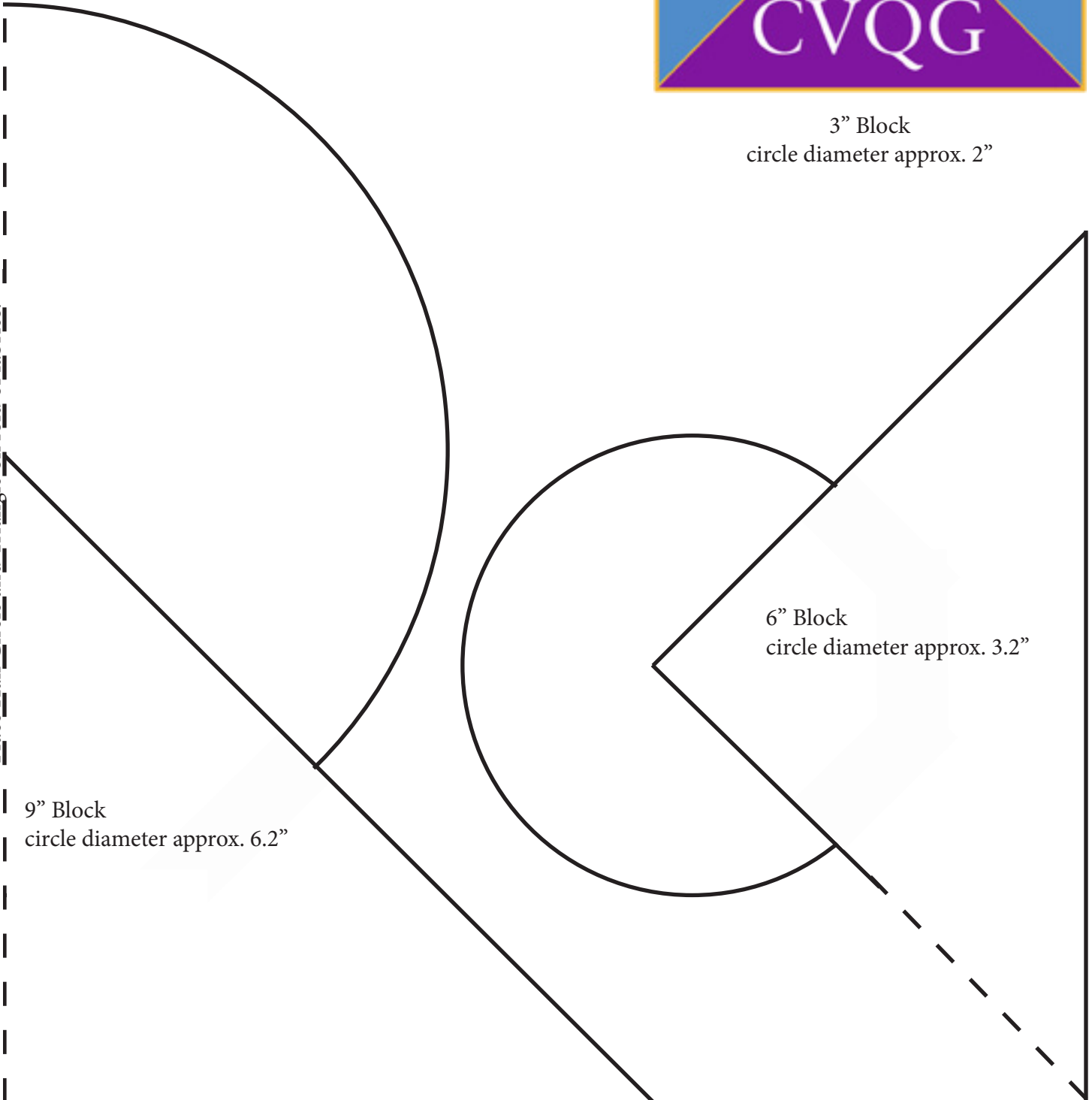


3" Block
circle diameter approx. 2"

Place Half Circle and Triangle on fold of fabrics.

9" Block
circle diameter approx. 6.2"

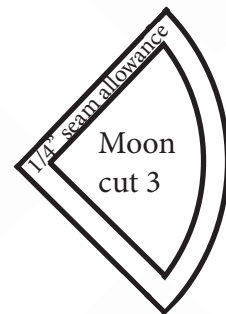
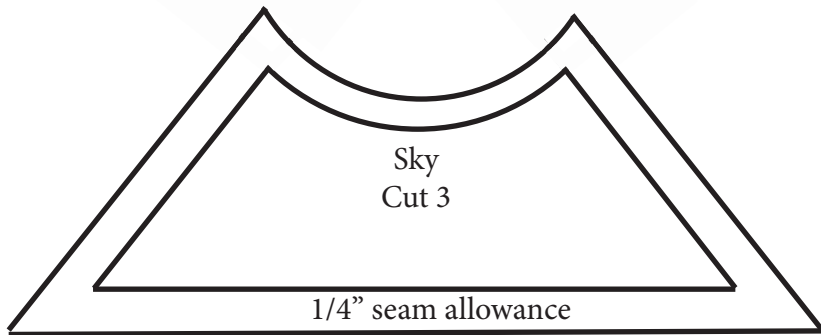
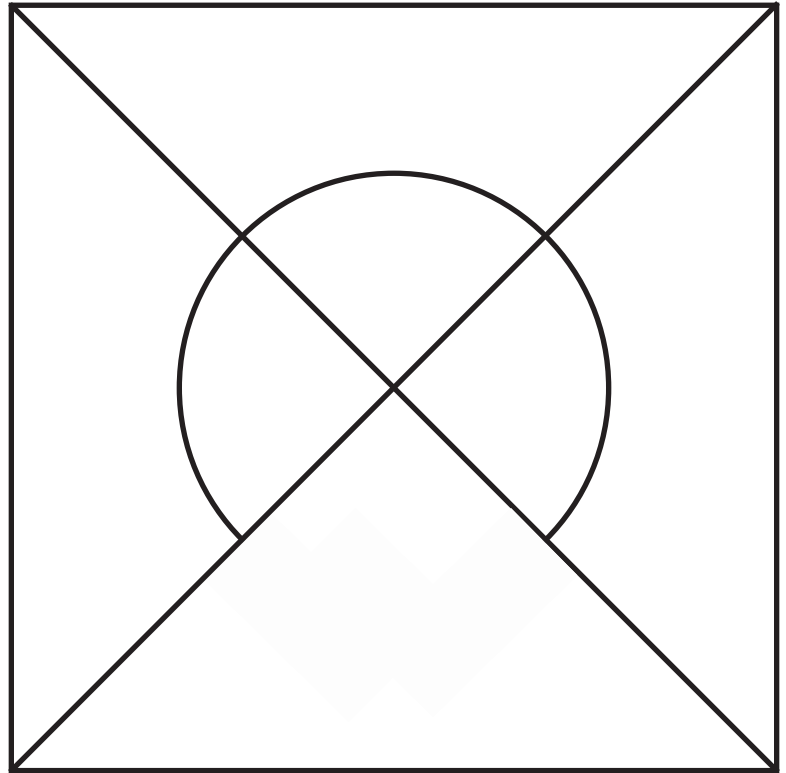
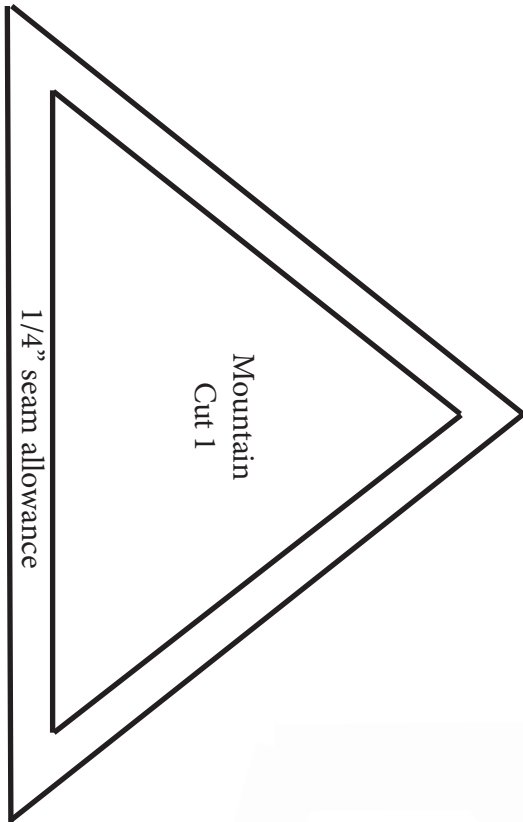
6" Block
circle diameter approx. 3.2"

“Moon Over The Mountain”

Pattern and instructions to make your badge. Many of us have made borders beyond the square for decorative pins. Please make the badge and put your first name on it. Thanks!!!



Cut out 1 mountain piece, three moon pieces and 3 sky pieces. Cut on outside lines and sew on inside lines. Sew a moon piece to each sky piece forming triangles. (By hand or machine. . .some people prefer to stay stitch the curves and clip before sewing.) Clip. Join two triangles together. Sew the mountain triangle to one of the sky and moon triangles. Join the two large triangles together to form the pattern.
