Section #4: Short and Tall Evergreens/Big & Little Trees

EQ location: Short and Tall Evergreens – Foundation Pieced/Trees

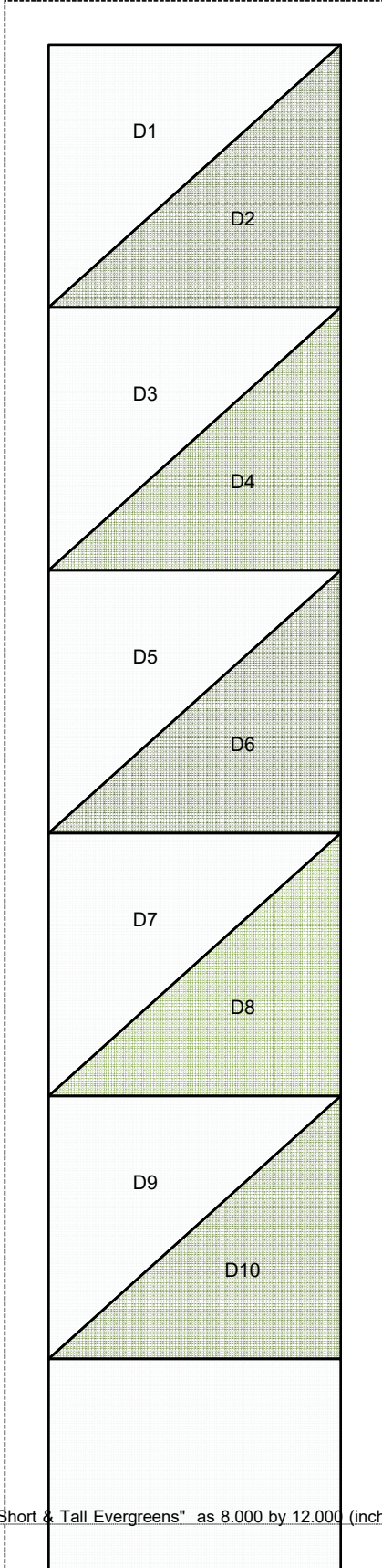
Big & Little Trees – Contemporary Pieced/Trees

Construction:

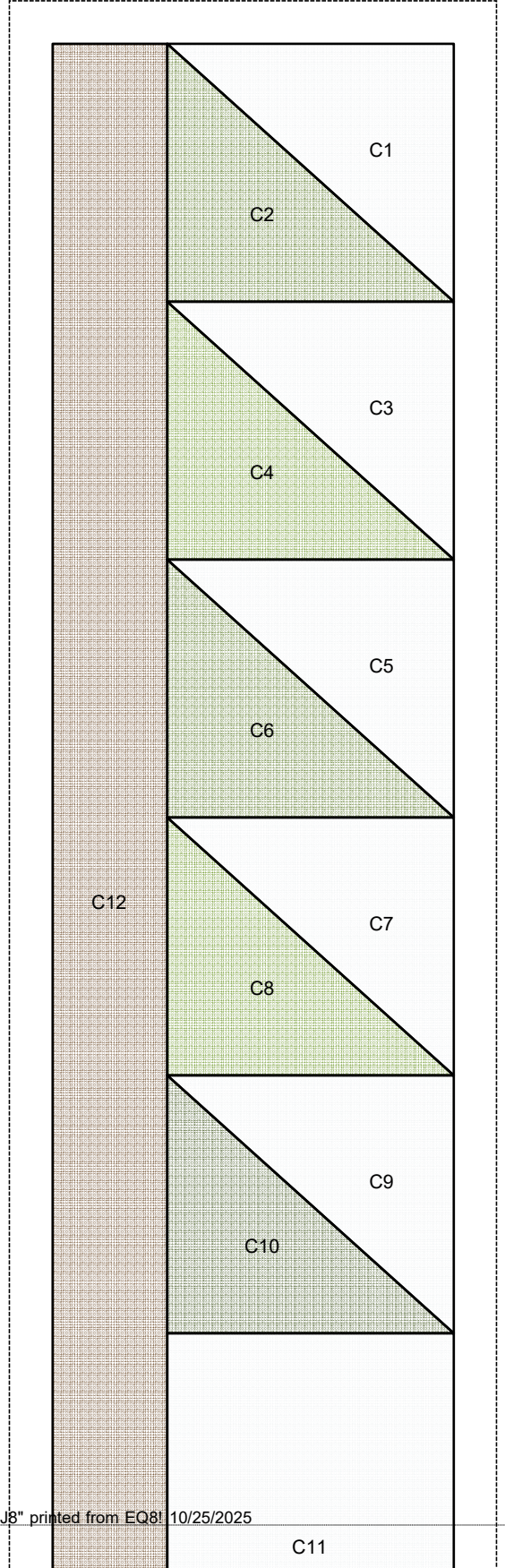
- Make 3 – 4.5” four patch units or use the ones you made ahead. Sew together in a row.
- Make 1 – 2.5” x 4.5” two patch unit. Sew this unit to the right end of the four patch unit as shown.
- Construct the “Short and Tall Evergreens” using Foundation piecing. Square this unit to measure 8.5” wide x 12.5” tall (unfinished). Note: the angles of the tree branches are not a 45 degree cut. Cut squares 3” square. Lay these squares face down beside the paper unit. Position a line on the ruler over the stitching line. Use this angle to cut the squares to get the correct angle.
- Construct the “Big & Little Trees” using either Foundation or templates. Square this unit to 6.5” wide x 12.5” tall. (unfinished)
- Sew these two units together as shown.
- Sew the checker board to the top of the tree unit.
- Square Section 4 to: **14.5” wide x 16.5” tall. (unfinished)**
- Finished size is 14”wide x 16” tall when sewn into the top.

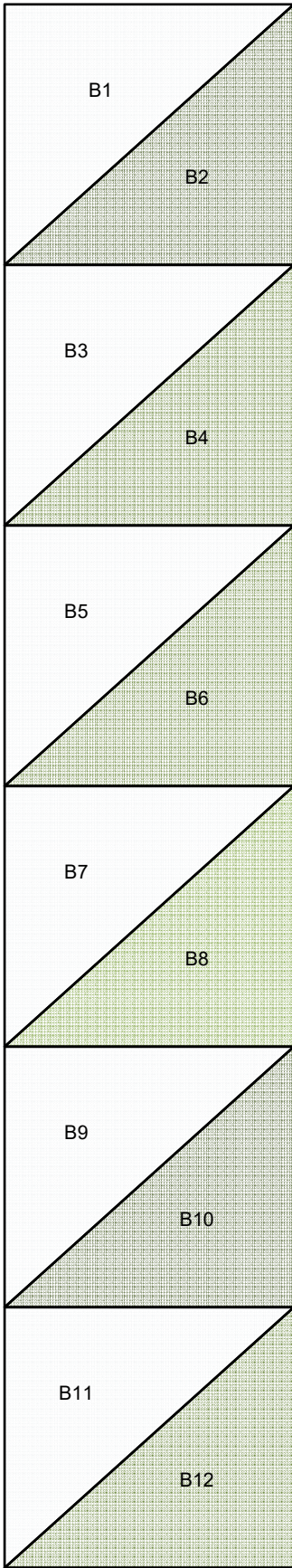
Short & Tall Evergreens

Unit 1 - Left trees

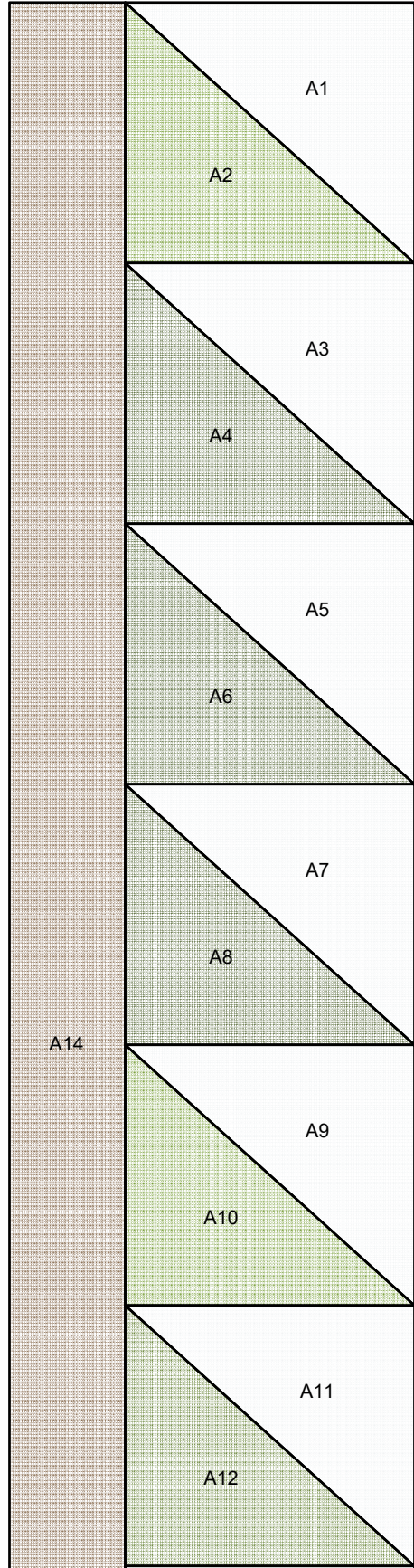


D & C - right tree
