

2.5" Scrappy Squares Table Runner



Half yard of background fabric (in example above dark blue – on brown examples background is white)

Cut – Four 2-1/2" strips WOF

Cut -Two 1-1/2" strips WOF
Sub-cut – Four 1-1/2" x 12" pieces

Scraps:

48 – 2-1/2" squares dark fabrics

24 -2-1/2" squares light/medium fabrics

OR: Several miscellaneous jelly roll strips

1. Make 12 - Strip sets #1: (using 2-1/2" squares in this order) – background + color + color + color
2. Make 12 - Strip sets #2: (using 2-1/2" squares in this order) – color + color + background + color
3. Using the strip sets arrange as follows:

Strip sets will look like this:

B	C	C	C
C	B	C	C
C	C	B	C
C	C	C	B

B = Background Square

C = Scrap Squares

4. Sew together strip sets, order shown above, to create a block - background squares should line up down the middle on the diagonal. Make six of these blocks

5. Cut each block on the diagonal once through the background squares creating 2 triangle segments)



6. Using four triangle segments (*take from several of the blocks*) arrange so background squares are on the outside.



Sew these four triangles together

7. Sash with 1-1/2" strips. Points will be lost which gives blocks a rounded look

To make a quilt top, make more blocks. Blocks are approximately 11" square before sashing
