Supply list - choose one!



Spooky Spider Table Runner (finished size 27 1/2" diameter)

Materials:

- * 1/4 yard each of six Halloween prints/colors
- * 1/3 yard black solid
- * Scraps of white tonal
- * 32" X 32" backing
- * 32" X 32" batting
- * 2 (7/16" diameter) black buttons
- * Fusible web with paper release
- * Template material (I have made copies for the class!)
- * Thread
- * Sewing Machine
- * Basic sewing tools and supplies, including a ruler with a 60-degree line

I will bring a 60-degree triangle ruler and a ruler with a 60-degree line for use at class.

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Holly Days Table Topper (finished size 28" diameter)

Materials:

- * 1/8 yard each of four green tonals/print and one red/green print
- * 1/8 yard each red dot, pink dot and black tonal

- * 1/4 yard red text or print
- * 1/2 yard red/white print
- * 30" square gray/white/other (background fabric)
- * Small piece each of three white tonals and one black tonal
- * 32" X 32" backing
- * 32" X 32" batting
- * 3/16" diameter buttons: 8 black; 4 red
- * 4 (1/2" diameter) white buttons
- * 4 (1 1/4" diameter) white snowflake buttons
- * 14" square piece of paper (parchment or freezer paper works well)
- * Fusible web with paper release
- * Template material (I have already made copies for the class)
- * Thread to match
- * Sewing Machine
- * Basic sewing tools and supplies (including a small iron and mat if you like)

I used small pom poms for Santa's hat and his nose instead of buttons. I will have extras at the class. I will also bring 505 basting spray if needed for assembling your topper.
